



Teach your dog the

STAY Command

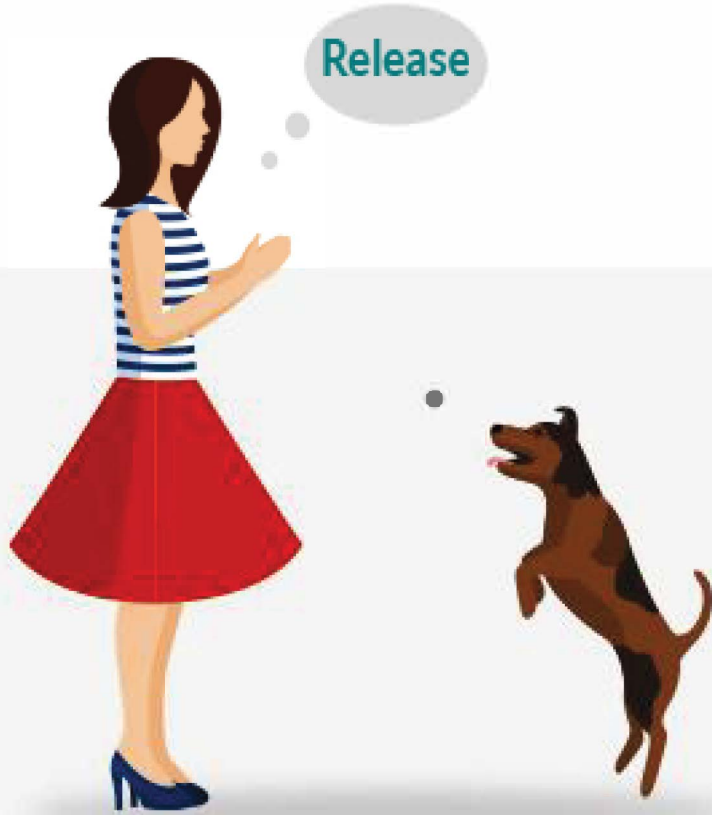
Dogs can sometimes be very needy and disturb you while you are busy working. The Stay and Release command will help you teach your dog not to interrupt you while you are working.

Here is how you teach your dog the stay command



Stand in front of your dog and maintain a constant eye contact then raise your hand in front of your dog's face with the palm facing him.

Say "Stay" in a very firm voice.



Move a little away but not too much. If he moves say stay again with a firm voice. Count to ten and come back to his side. Say 'Release' and give him a treat.

Repeat this by slowly increasing the distance between you and your dog.
